Dear Secretary Spencer:

We are deeply troubled by the recent news stories suggesting that the United States Navy has put together a proposal to create tent camps for undocumented immigrants on Department of Defense-owned land, including at Concord Naval Weapons Station in Concord, California.

As Members who represent Northern California, the safety and wellbeing of our constituents and our community are our top priority. That concern extends to the 47,000 individuals the Administration is reportedly considering to relocate to Concord. As such, **we are requesting a copy of the pre-decisional brief authored by Assistant Secretary for the Navy for Energy, Installations and Environment containing the proposal for "temporary and austere" facilities to house thousands of immigrants on land owned by the Department of Defense.**<sup>1</sup>

We are understandably concerned that such a drastic proposal is being considered without community input or notification. We call on you as Members of Congress to provide us with the report and we would appreciate the courtesy of a response to this request by June 28, 2018. Thank you for your attention to this matter. We look forward to your response.




