I am requesting funding for the **Appian Way Pedestrian Crossing Enhancements Project** in surface transportation reauthorization legislation.

The project sponsor for this project is **Contra Costa County Public Works Department** and the project is located at Appian Way, El Sobrante, California, 94803.

The funding is designated for the installation of pedestrian-activated flashing beacons at five intersections for non-motorized and disabled users.
