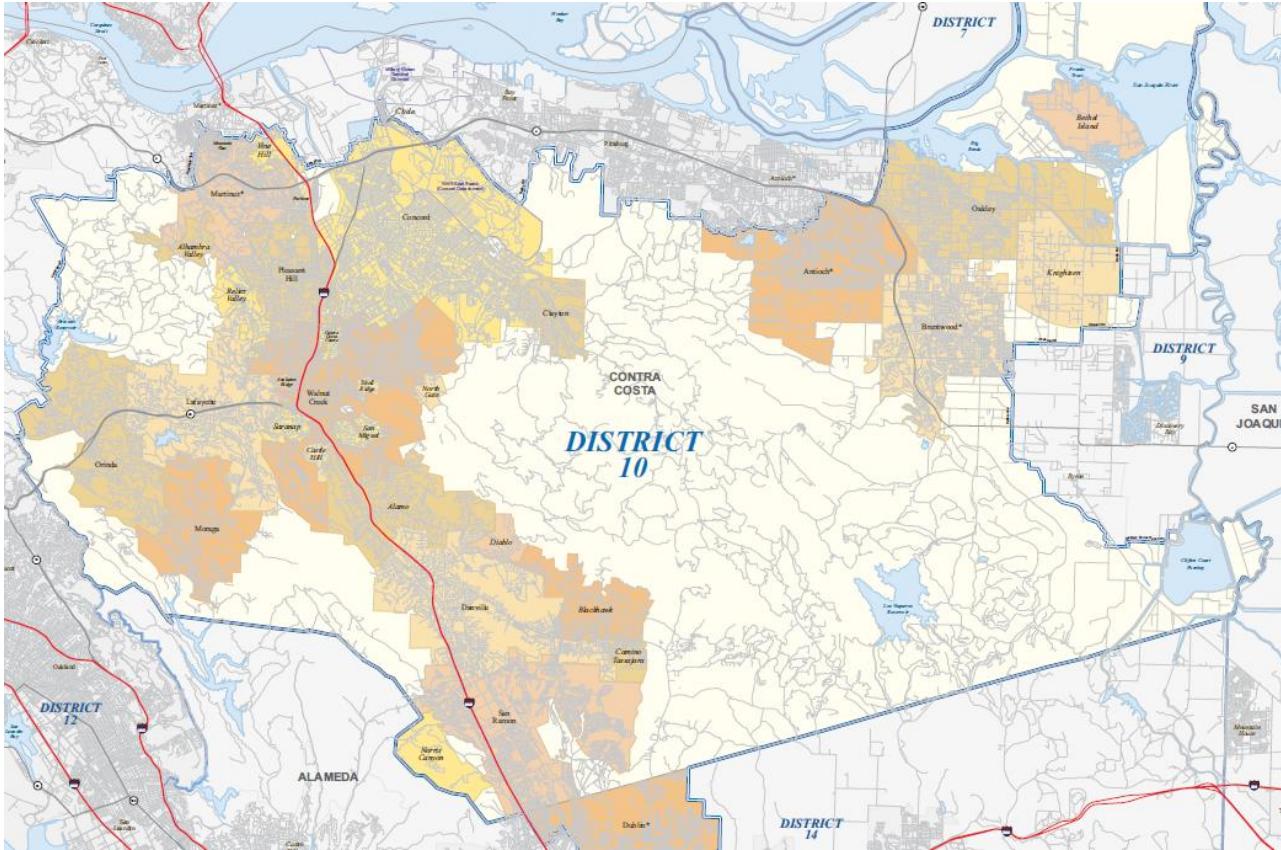
HOUSE ETHICS: CONGRESSIONAL VS. CAMPAIGN ACTIVITY

- Members of Congress are governed by the House Code of Official Conduct, which includes standards for whether, how, when, and where Members may engage in campaign activity.
 - This town hall is being hosted in my official capacity as Representative for California's 10th District, not as a candidate in a campaign. Therefore, House Rules prevent me from:
 - Solicitating, receiving, and accepting campaign contributions.
 - Making political endorsements.
 - Directing attendees to websites, resources, or events created or operated by a campaign or any campaign-related entity, including political parties and campaign committees.

THE MANY BENEFITS OF IMMIGRATION

Immigration has strengthened our communities economically and culturally and turned the United States into a global beacon of prosperity and opportunity. Some of immigration's many benefits include:

- Immigration is expected to add \$8.9 trillion to the GDP between 2024 and 2034.
- Asian-Americans own an estimated 650,680 businesses in the United States.
- As the average age of the U.S.-born population rises, immigrants make up a growing percentage of the labor force, currently 18.1%.
- 18% of healthcare workers were born outside the United States, and nearly 20% of workers in STEM fields who contribute to American leadership in scientific research and technological innovation are immigrants.
