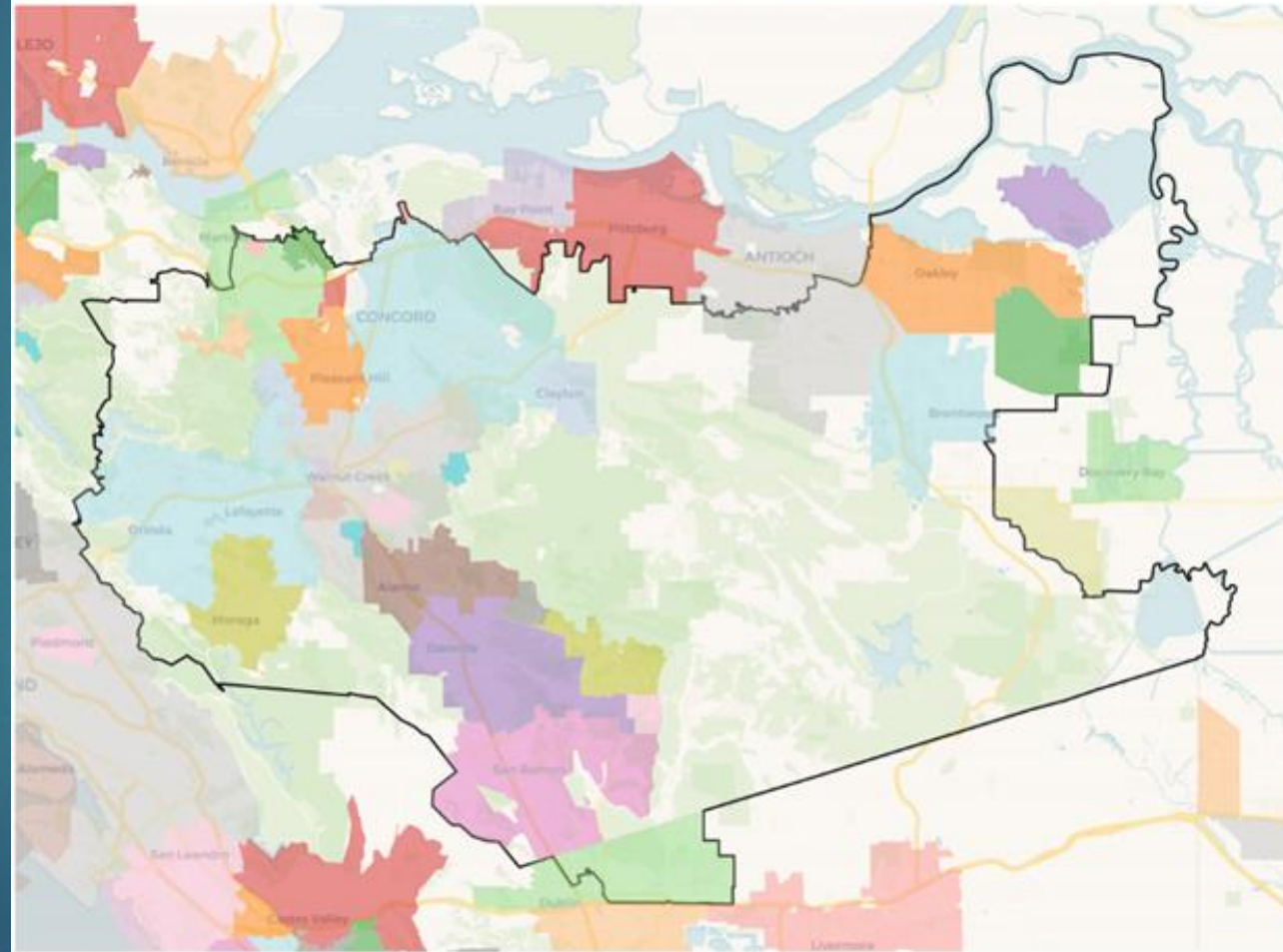

Our District, Outreach, and Constituent Services

- ▶ Congressman DeSaulnier represents California's 10th District, which includes most of Contra Costa County and a part of Alameda County.
 - ▶ Following redistricting in the 118th Congress, he now represents more of Antioch as well as Brentwood, Oakley, San Ramon, and parts of Dublin.
- ▶ Since coming to Congress, Mark has:
 - ▶ Hosted 176 town halls
 - ▶ Assisted over 9,600 constituents with federal issues
 - ▶ Responded to over 774,000 constituent inquiries.

Legislative Successes

- ▶ Over 60 bills passed into law, including:
 - ▶ Increased funding for electric vehicle charging stations and several other provisions in the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law
 - ▶ A bill to provide Isabel Bueso and her parents permanent status in the U.S. so she can continue to receive lifesaving treatment for her rare disease
 - ▶ A measure to allow Head Start programs to run more efficiently
 - ▶ Bipartisan legislation to expand the John Muir National Historic Site and improve access to the park and its scenic trails
 - ▶ A measure to protect the public from faulty guardrails on roads and highways
 - ▶ Funding for 25 community projects totaling over \$30 million
